Some things will be the same and some things will be different when you return.





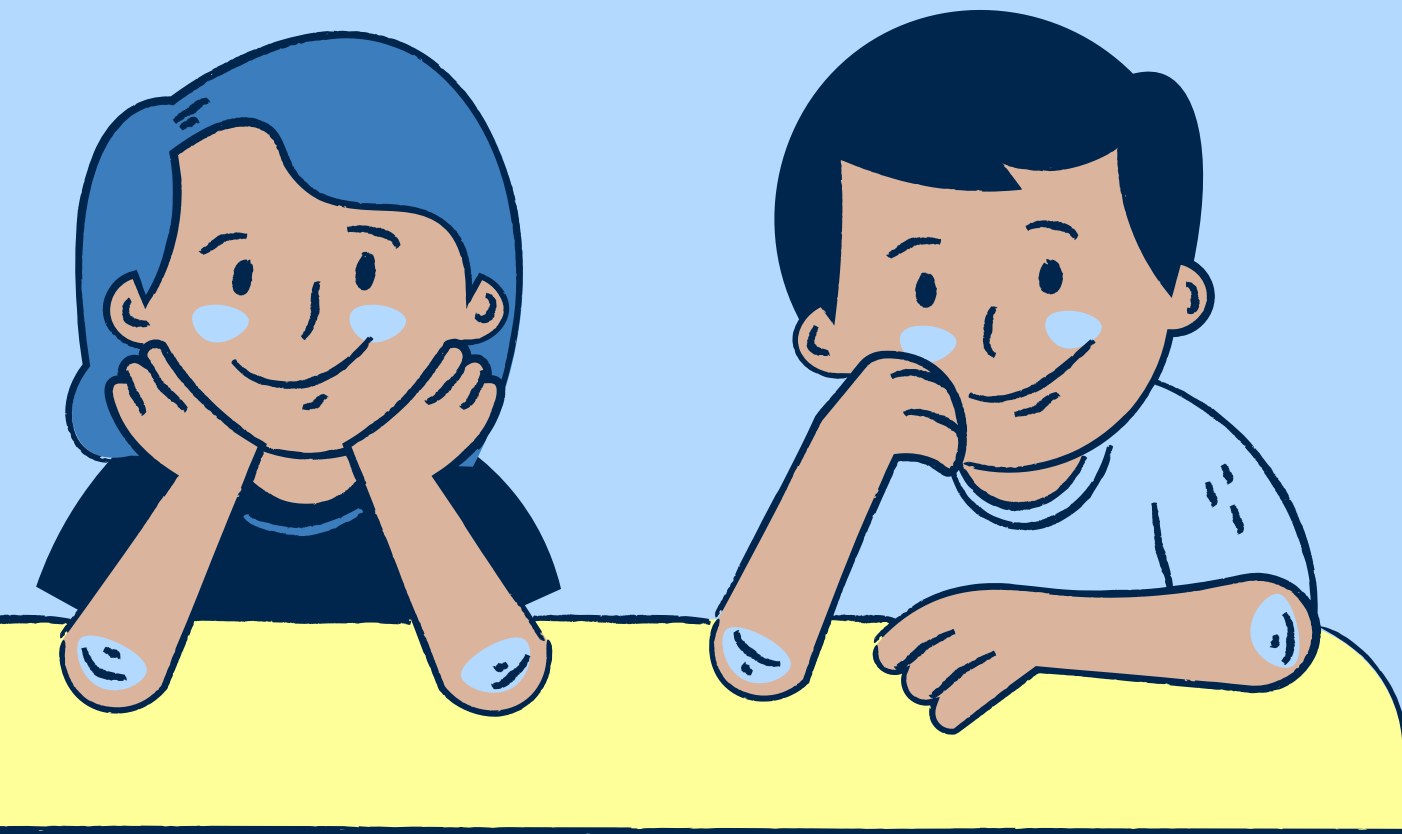
The rules are the same. Our expectations are the same:

day.



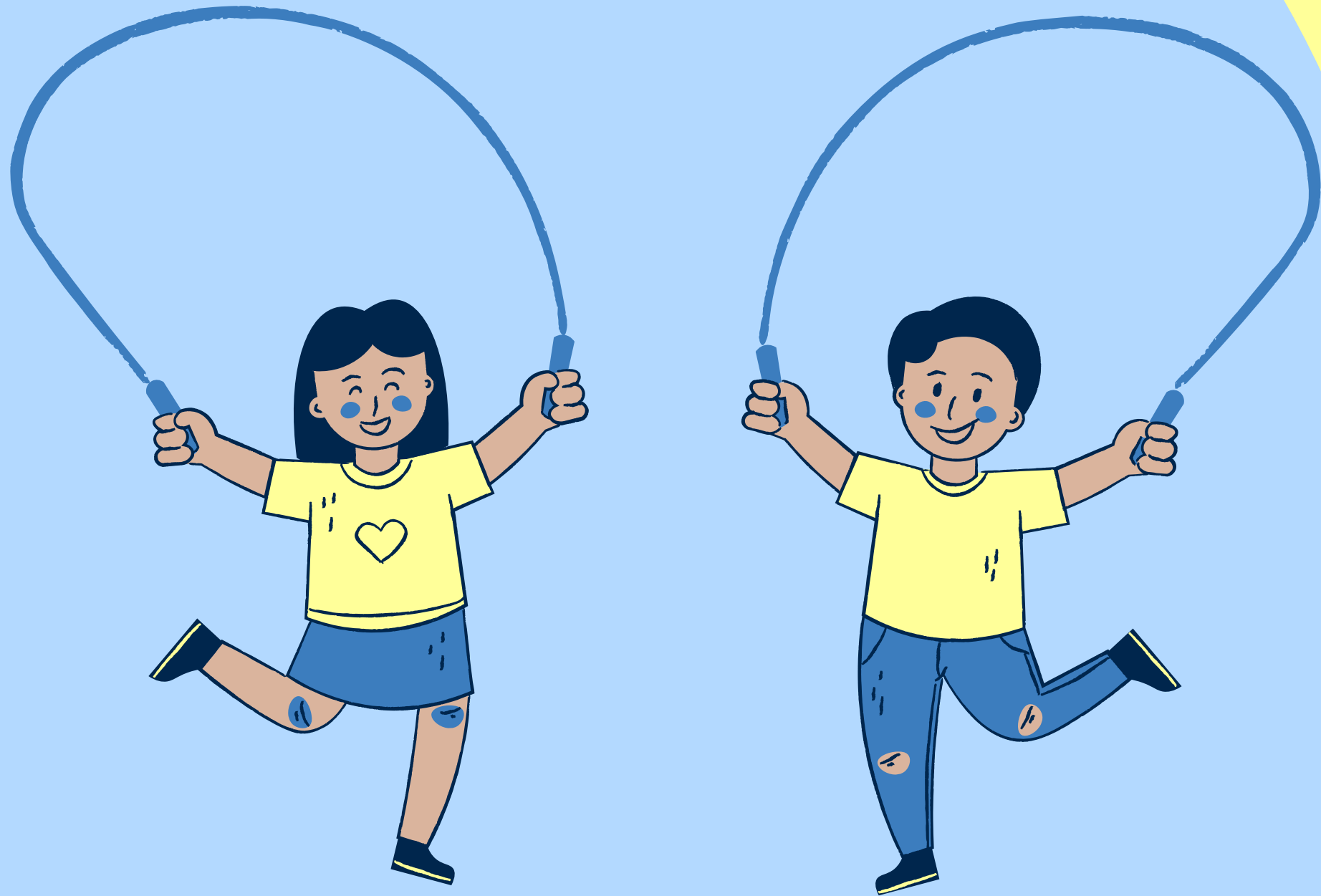




All school staff will be wearing face masks indoors. Some students may be wearing face masks too.

When you arrive in the morning after 8.55am, you will leave your bag outside your classroom or in the bag room. You will not go into your classroom.



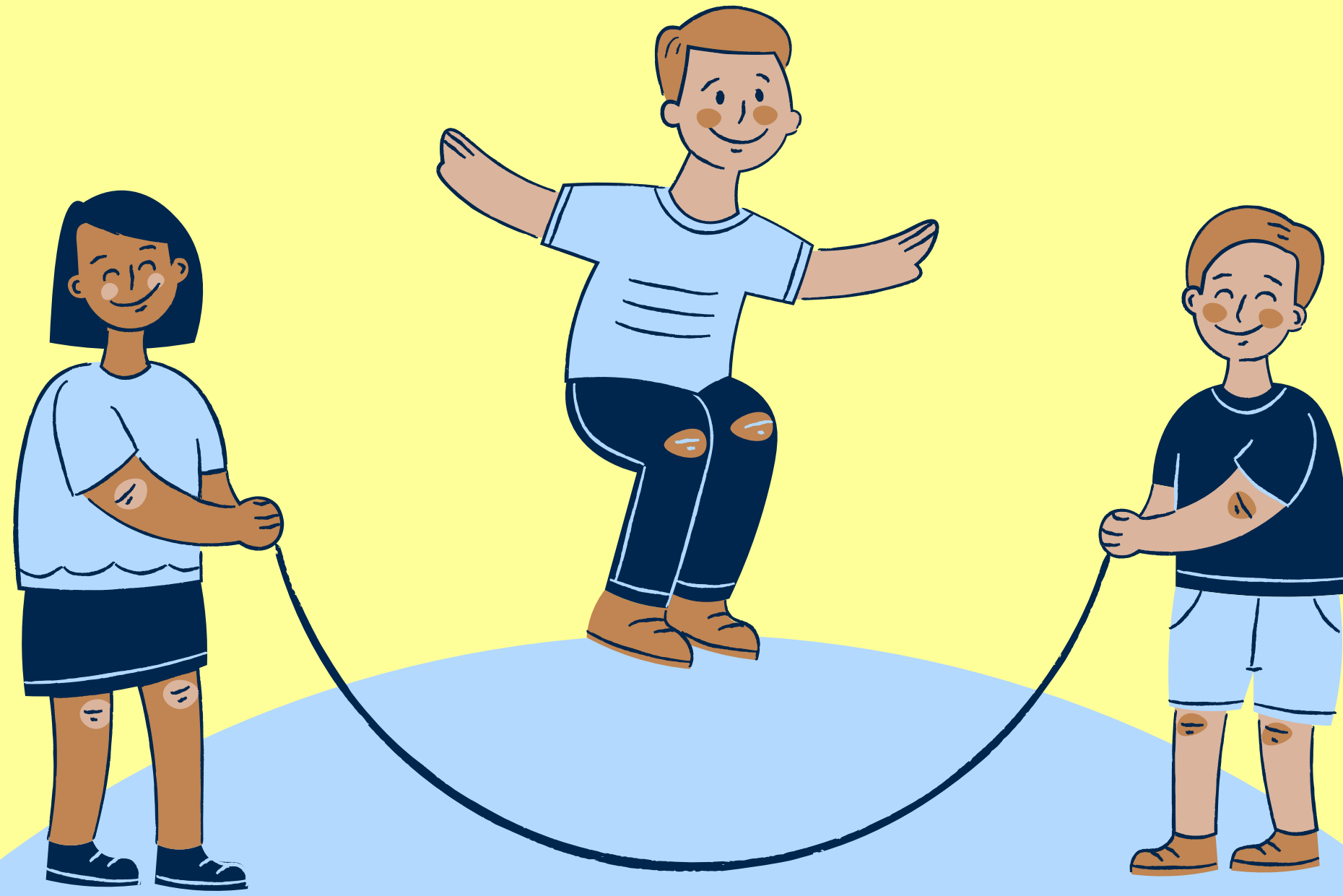

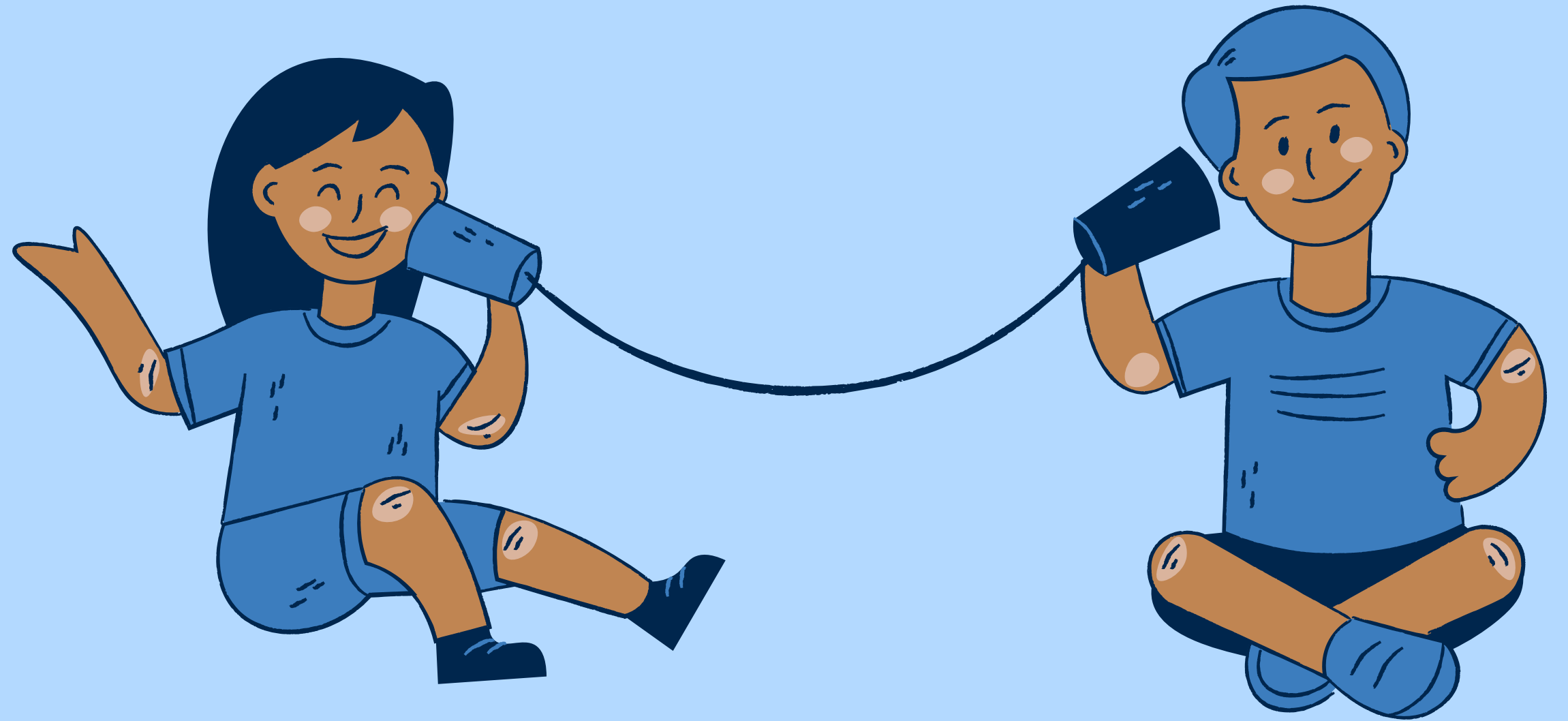

All students need to know their pick up plan.

- Older siblings of Kinder students leave at 3.15pm and must meet their siblings and parent at their nominated gate.
- Older siblings of Year 1 students leave at 3.20pm and must meet their siblings and parent at their nominated gate.
- Walkers along with bike, bus and ferry riders leave at the 3:25pm bell.
- Bus riders meet the teacher on duty near the play equipment.
- Ferry walkers/riders meet the teacher on duty on the verandah.
- Older siblings of students in other grades must collect their younger brothers and sisters and escort them to where they need to be.
