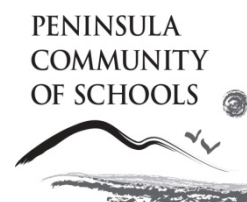

Early Bird All Day Ride Tickets

All day ride tickets are available for purchase at a discounted price of \$25 on the Flexischools website before midnight on Friday 11th October; and will be on sale at the school outside the hall on Wednesday 9th October from 3-4pm, and Thurs 10th & Friday 11th October from 8:30am-9:30am. Get in early to save. All day tickets will be available on the day of the fete for \$30. Individual ride tickets will be available for \$5.

Monster Skate Park & Parkour

There will be a Monster Skate Park skate/scoot area set up on the netball court on the day of the fete and also a Parkour area. Admission to both areas will cost \$2. Entry will be given to kids in small groups at a time to ensure the safety of the areas and we ask parents to help enforce this. Instructors will be on hand to put kids through their paces in both areas. Children are welcome to bring their own skateboards, scooters, helmets and pads but there will be some available on the day should they prefer not to. **Skating and scooting is not allowed anywhere else on school grounds on the day of the fete.** Also no bikes will be permitted anywhere on school grounds or in the skate area. Please ensure your children are aware of these rules.

All our amazing Lego entries will be on exhibit in the school hall on the day of the fete. A donation box will be at the entry to help cover the costs of the exhibition. All Lego winners will be announced and prizes awarded on the main stage in the Kindergarten playground at 11am.
