Last Wednesday, 19 Newport students competed in the Mid Northern Beaches Primary Schools One -Day Tournament held at Pittwater House Collaroy. Teams of three played seven rounds of chess over the course of the day in a Swiss format system. Of the six teams Newport sent, it was the Newport A team (Thiago Ortiz - captain, Aaron Hughes and Thomas Poppleton) who with a score of 19 from a possible 21 points won the event with a 3 point lead. The team gained State selection and were awarded a trophy each and one for the school. Congratulations boys! A big thankyou to Mr Cooper who coordinated the teams and attended the match. Thankyou also to our parent transporters.

With just three days to prepare for the weekend's State Finals in North Sydney, the team were back in their Newport uniforms on Sunday and off to North Sydney Boys to meet the best chess players from 47 Independent and Public Schools from across NSW. With some very tough matches Newport A finished a credible 13th overall with St Ives North taking out the event.

There are no more Interschools competitions for the year now, however, social chess will continue in the music room on Thursdays. The targeted Kindergartens are enjoying their Thursday chess club and have learnt about the board and how to set up the pieces.
