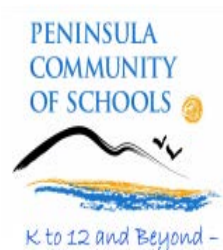

The Green Sea Turtle Project is an in-situ conservation student leadership program aimed at supporting beach litter awareness, campaign creation and student-led action in the coastal area on Sydney's northern peninsula.

Our leaders have participated in the first stage of the program to become ambassadors for the Green Sea Turtle through the development of a campaign to spread the Take 3 message. They have started to become experts and advocates for marine creatures, in particular the Green Sea Turtle. They have started to increase their knowledge of beach litter, marine creature threats, human activities that will help protect these animals and communication techniques to help them run a 6 week campaign at Newport.

This campaign will be aimed at educating the Newport community about the plight of the green sea turtle and the things we can do to stop beach pollution and improve the state of our oceans. Our leaders will be documenting their campaign and present it at Taronga Zoo during the middle of this term.
