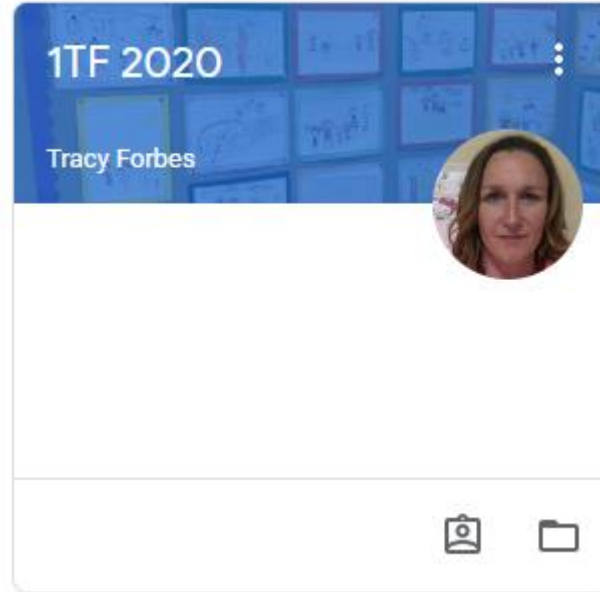
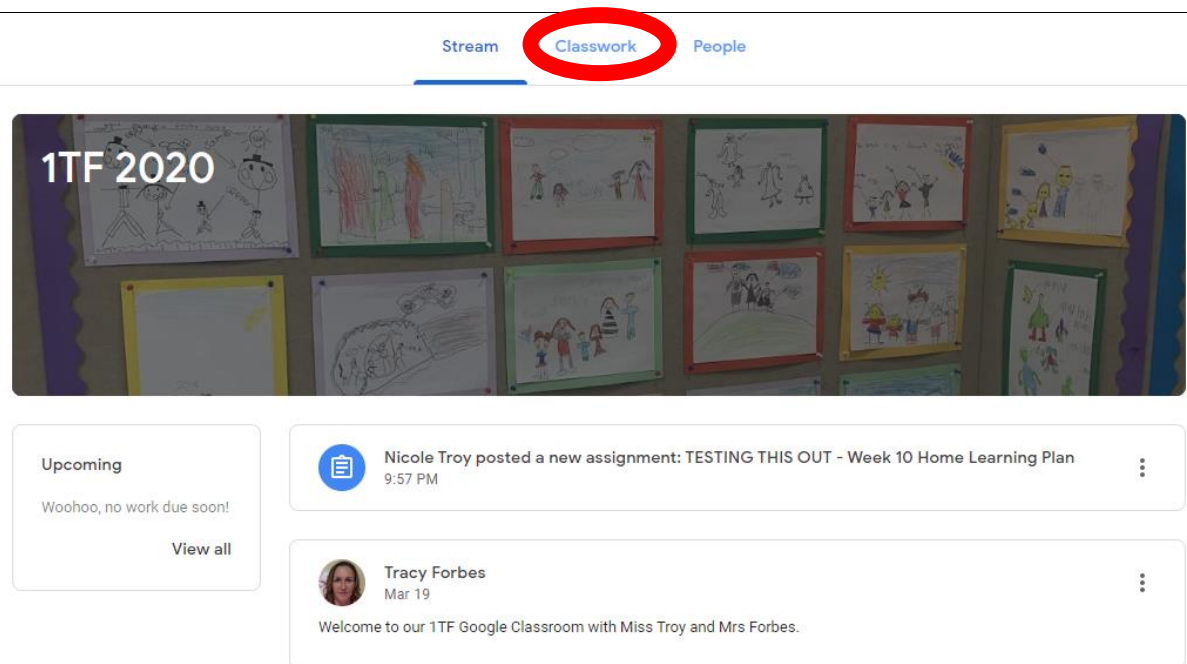


How to find an assignment your teacher has set and how to upload work to Google Classroom
